President's Report – Michelle Schmit

New Business

- 1. School code of conduct. Schools are obligated to discuss the code, which goes into students' agendas, once a year with parents, staff, and students. Our review saw some changes to wording of our code, such as changing the word "sex" to "gender," replacing the word "orderly" with "inclusive," creating more kidfriendly verbiage in the "Response to Inappropriate and/or Unacceptable Behaviour" section, and ensuring there is restitution at the closing of each incident. To be worked on and included in the code will be something around photography and being digitally responsible. Michelle C. to forward some information on what Stelly's has crafted in this regard. This also sparked discussion around ensuring proper signage for gender-neutral restroom by the ELL room.
- 2. Bring a big buddy/ Hot dog day. June 16. Lunch to be served at noon. Michelle S. will do a Sign-up Genius volunteer sheet for the six necessary volunteers for serving. Use Country Grocer coupons for gluten-free and vegetarian options. Supplies to be purchased for 350 people.

Sanjiv Galhon is coming from Rock Heights to teach Grade 5 next year, Andrea Jardim is joining us teaching a Grade 3/4 class, and Misha Gibson is leaving Division 11 and moving in to teach Grade 2/3. Currently posted positions are music teacher, Kindergarten, Kindergarten/Grade 1, Grade 4/5, a behaviour support teacher the District is funding for one year, an ELL teacher, and a temporary Grade 3/4 for Kristy Gregson who is going to remain on parental leave for one more year.
