# **CANADA DENTAL BENEFIT FOR CHILDREN UNDER 12:**

The Government of Canada has launched the <u>Canada Dental Benefit</u>, to **help reduce dental costs for eligible families** earning less than \$90,000 per year. Parents and guardians can apply if the child receiving dental care is under 12 years old and they do not have access to a private dental insurance plan.

To help families navigate the application process, BCDA has collected resources and created an FAQ on the Canada Dental Benefit on our yourdentalhealth.ca public education website, including an information poster translated into several languages including Arabic, Chinese, Hindi, Punjabi, Tagalog, and Ukrainian.
