Principal's Message:

Today we took part in The Great BC ShakeOut earthquake drill. While potential earthquake hazards depend on your location, everywhere in BC is considered at high risk in relation to the rest of Canada. The drill provided the opportunity to practice how to be safer during earthquakes and engage students to practice 'Drop, Cover and Hold On'.

We have had a couple of close calls in our upper parking lot and in the drive-through/drop off/pick up area. Please remember that the upper lot is for **staff only** and should not be used as a drop off or pick up location for students. In addition, **cars should not be left unattended** when using the pull through lane or the parallel 'waiting' spots in the pull through area. If you are waiting in that lane for your child, please continue to move forward as space allows so that other cars can safely turn in off of Raymond Street. The two lower parking lots provide ample space for parent parking and quick access to the school grounds for students.
