

What to do:

Get yourself a pumpkin, decorate it (uncarved) as a character from a book. Bring your pumpkin to the library on Monday Oct. 28. Pumpkins will be on display for the week.

*Please Feel free to bring a picture of the book or the book itself labeled with your name to display with your pumpkin.

Book Character Pumpkin CONTEST RULES:

You can use accessories for your pumpkin entry. Only one entry per student.

- -There can be no carved entries as the pumpkin will decay more quickly
- -This is an optional activity
- -You can also make a book character entry by only using a tissue box and art supplies
- -You may use pumpkins or gourds or both to create your project
- -To decorate: use paper, glue, paint, markers, pipe cleaners, fabric, or other craft items on the pumpkin or tissue box. Be CREATIVE!
- -Projects must represent a book character from a book/graphic novel
- -On the entry form, please write the title and author of the book
- -Feel free to bring a picture of the book cover or a copy of the book to display with your pumpkin
- -This is a <u>home project</u> and entries should be done mostly by the students, but parents or other family members may help you pick out an idea.

Please bring your pumpkin or tissue box project to school by Monday, October 28.
