November Math Tip: Model Positive Attitudes Towards Math

- 1. Have fun together while doing math-related activities
- 2. Encourage flexibility in thinking by encouraging and allowing many ways to approach a problem; "Can you think of a different way to solve this problem?";
- 3. Spend time talking about your positive math experiences in school and life. Children are often influenced by the attitudes of the adults around them; "When I was a kid I used to love playing card games too" or "Math can be hard, but if we keep trying we'll get it"
