Why do we ask families to complete a survey?

Information collected in the survey helps us to:

- Identify children and parents/guardians who are interested in participating
- Understand how families get to and from your school
- Plan a safe route based on where interested families are located
- Recruit volunteer Bike Bus Leaders

The deadline to complete this survey is **Wednesday**, **February 5**.

Note that at this stage, we are gathering information required to determine *if* we can run a Bike Bus at your school this Spring. Completing this process does not guarantee a Bike Bus will run at your school in Spring 2025.
