#### Tuition-Free Eligibility:

This summer program is tuition-free. All snacks, learning materials, and field trips are included at no cost. Please note that daily transportation to and from the SJ Willis Education Centre is not provided.

#### Attendance Expectations:

Daily attendance is essential. Please do not register your child unless you can commit to full attendance.

There are two key reasons for this policy:

- The fast pace of summer programming makes it difficult to catch up on missed learning.
- The Ministry of Education and Child Care only provides funding for students who attend from the start.

Registering and then missing classes may also take away a valuable spot from another student.
