As we did last year, we are using an app called school appointments to schedule interviews. Please use the following link http://mck.schoolappointments.com to book your interviews.

Appointments can be booked starting at 7:00am on Monday, October 13th until 7pm on Sunday, October 19th.

The parent instruction sheet (below) should provide you with the information required to create an account and book your appointment times, however if you require assistance, please do not hesitate to contact the school office.

*Reminder that students will be <u>dismissed at lunchtime (11:50 a.m.) on Wednesday, October 22nd</u> to accommodate the parent teacher interviews.

School Appointments - Parent Instructions

- 1. Go to our school appointments web site for your school: http://mck/schoolappointments.com
- Register for an account by clicking the "REGISTER" menu tab and filling in the on-line form.Choose a user id and password for yourself and then click the "Register Now" button.
- Add your children into the system by clicking the "Add a Student" button. Click "Insert New" button to add more children.
- 4. Click the "date" icon beside each child's name to schedule appointments.



Select the staff you wish to book appointments with. Use the "Ctrl" or "Command" key to select multiple staff to view at the same time.



- 6. Select how your meetings will be held.
- 7. Then click the "View Calendars" button.
- 8. Click on available time slots to book your appointments to make your bookings.

To Delete Appointments:

- 1. Click "View Appointments" from the HOME page.
- You will then see the list of appointments that you have booked. To delete any of the appointments, click the red "x" icon beside the appointment.
